PLEASE BE ON TIME. Allow time for you to walk your dog. We have a great deal to cover and the time passes very quickly.

WEAR COMFORTABLE CLOTHING. We will be sitting on the floor some of the time. Sneakers are the preferred footwear. Please - no flip flop/sandal type shoes!

PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG. Pick up bags and a disposal container will be available. Bring a flashlight so you can see to clean up.

BRING THE LEASH AND COLLAR THAT YOU HAVE NOW. We prefer buckle or snap collars. If you are using a harness, we suggest a front fastening one. We will discuss this the first night and may suggest a different type collar or harness than you are currently using. Please check with us before buying new equipment. We do not use choke collars. No Flexi-Leads are allowed.

If there are no parking places out front please CIRCLE AROUND THE BACK OF THE MALL AND PARK IN THE UPPER LOT. (see map on website). Come down the stairs from the upper lot. The entrance is on the side of the building facing the upper lot.

Each night bring some treats that your dog can eat quickly. You will need three types of treats (good, better, best). Bring more than you think you will need. Suggestions are: Hot Dogs, String Cheese, cooked Chicken.

FOLLOW YOUR VETERINARIAN'S RECOMMENDATION FOR VACCINATIONS. PLEASE BRING PROOF OF CURRENT VACCINATIONS THE FIRST NIGHT OF CLASS.

ELIGIBILITY. Females in season are not allowed in class. Dogs with any aggression or reactive issues need to be evaluated by the instructor before enrolling in any class.
